VENDOR'S AGREEMENT

1. Booth setup will be from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm on Thursday, December 1st and 8:00 am to 10:45 am on Friday, December 2nd.
2. All vendors are expected to be set up and ready for business by 11:00 am on Friday, December 2nd. All vendors are expected to remain until the close of business each day of the event unless prior arrangements are made.
3. Each indoor display space will be approximately 10' deep and 10' wide. Vendors are permitted to rent **2 consecutive spaces** for their set-ups, as available.
4. FCC&T reserves the right to determine what items/displays are NOT appropriate for this event.
5. There are limited tables available from F&M Trust. If you need a table, please contact us and we will reserve as available.
6. Tables must be skirted or draped to the floor with no visible signs of clutter protruding or showing.
7. Vendors are responsible for their trash during and after the event. Limited trash receptacles are available. A clean-up charge may be assessed if necessary.
8. A valid PA Sales Tax number is required for any vendor who intends to sell items. Not-for-Profit groups are excluded from this requirement.
9. The Fulton County Chamber of Commerce & Tourism and F&M Trust provide NO insurance coverage for your booth or contents. Each participant is responsible for providing your own insurance coverage.
10. **There will be absolutely NO REFUNDS for cancellations.**
